

## Minutes of the Special Called Booster Meeting April 6, 2006

Deborah Luna called the meeting to order and gave the purpose of the meeting: To vote on whether or not to purchase a trailer made available to us by an 8<sup>th</sup> grade band parent. We have \$2000 set aside in the bank in the trailer fund - \$1000 from a parent donation and \$1000 set aside from the fruit sale last fall.

Mr. Faires and Donnie Helms went to look at the trailer. It has lighting inside and racks on top (was used to carry paint supplies and ladders for a professional painter.)

Tommie Farley checked into getting a tag for it and it will cost 3% of it's value for taxes, \$40 for the title transfer and \$19 for the license plate. Donnie Helms stated that by state law it would need to have a permanent tag and be titled to the school system.

Questions were raised about whether the trailer has a spare tire and if the tires on it are in good shape. The answers to these questions were not readily available, but Gary Farley stated that we would probably be able to get used tires donated by tire stores since we are a non-profit organization.

Priya Desai asked if we could get the uniforms as well as the instruments into the trailer. Mr. Faires stated that the trailer is large enough for both.

Tommie Farley stated that we have parents who are donating the money to have the lettering put on the trailer (Band of Pirates).

Tommie Farley made a motion that we purchase the trailer. Donnie Helms seconded the motion. Vote passed.
