

Minutes of the Band Booster Meeting #8 February 21, 2006

Deborah Luna called the meeting to order and went over the ground rules.

2. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and passed with no corrections.
3. Vanessa Stewart, treasurer, went over budget and financial reports. Nothing has changed for income except printer cartridges – Total for High is now \$56 Total for Middle is now \$332. Expenses that changed were All District Hotel \$266.20 and Concert Fees \$300. \$250 outstanding bills. Accepted Budget that was presented.
4. Old Business –

**Varsity Gold Cards – Voted and accepted for each child who sells the discount cards, \$1.00 per card will go towards their Band fees. Fundraiser starts March 3 and ends March 18, 2006. The company providing the cards will also provide the incentives.

**Committee Meetings – There were very little turnout for these meetings.

**Band Case – Mr. Faires wants all the Trophies to be put into our Display Case that is facing the front door. On the other side put our merchandise on display.

**Web Site – Vanessa is still working on setting up and getting approval from the school administrator to link to school website.

** Conflict of Interest Amendment – was approved. The only wording change was everywhere in the doc that said “governing board or committee” was changed to “governing board or committee or band boosters”.

5. New Business

**Wachovia Cup – Dates are May 1 thru May 7, 2006. Deborah Luna is working on setting up a 20-man booth to serve refreshments. At the end of the week, we will get a shift amount of pay. There will be 2 shifts per day, 20 people per shift needed. There is a 16-year-old age limit to work in the booths.

**Band Memorabilia Merchandise – was brought up by Tawnee Bounds. There is over \$1,500 worth of merchandise left to sell before we start to make any money on the merchandise. It was suggested that we ask Coach Rogers if we can sell memorabilia at the Basketball games or any remaining sporting events to recoup money spent. Tawnee also requested a report be provided at the next meeting that shows a breakdown of what was ordered, how much was ordered, how much each item costs, how many has been sold, and what is left in inventory.

**Beauty Pageant – Pageant up front money increased to \$1,000. Tommie Farley shared examples of trophies. She will get a committee in place when she has gathered all information.

**Adopt 06-07 Budget – Was accepted with some changes. New Uniform Fund was decreased to \$2,000. It was noted that the Winter Drumline Expenses were not being paid for by band booster money. It is a self-supporting group.

6. Directors comments –

**New Principal – will find out who the new principal is on March 7, 2006. Mr. Faires will schedule a meeting with the new principal.

**Winter Drumline placed 2nd Place at their competition and increased their score by 20 points.

** March concerts in Lincolnton will be held on March 21, 2006 for the high school and March 8 for the middle school. Time not set yet, either late morning or early pm.

**Middle School band students may be sharing a “Pen Pal” music with another school. Corresponding back & forth and then having a concert together at Wingate in late April.

May Concert – May 25, 2006.

Bob Deaton worked with the Band and said that they were doing great.

7. Liaison Comments – Mr. Dames was not present.

8. Coffee Talk

**Ron Hasty informed us that Gary Rogers here at Porter Ridge was going for his Eagle and has decided to take on building 4 instrument carts (like Sun Valley’s) for the band. They will be 4’ x 8’ and will be painted the colors that we choose.
