

Porter Ridge Band Booster Meeting Minutes  
Thursday, May 21, 2009

The final meeting of the 2008/2009 school year was held prior to the Spring Concert. Meeting was called to order at 7 pm.

Treasurer's report: Michele Bender was present and had available updated Profit & Loss and Balance Sheet reports. She also had printed invoices for the 2009/2010 band fees. These were handed out to the parents before the show. Parents were asked to please see Michele to pick up their invoice after the concert.

The main purpose of the meeting was to elect the band officers for the 2009/2010 school year. Beth Kitchen directed the voting process as follows:

- **PRESIDENT:** Beth and Kevin Kitchen are eligible to continue as co-presidents for another year according to the by-laws. The floor was opened up for nominations of any one who would wish to serve as president. No other nominations were received. The floor was opened for voting to allow Beth & Kevin to continue as co-presidents. The vote was received, seconded and carried with no opposing votes.
- **VICE-PRESIDENT:** Debbie Green is eligible to continue as vice-president for another year according to the by-laws. The floor was opened up for nominations of any one who would wish to serve as vice-president. No other nominations were received. The floor was opened for voting to allow Debbie to continue as vice-presidents. The vote was received, seconded and carried with no opposing votes.
- **SECRETARY:** Stephanie Phillips has served the Band Boosters for two years as the secretary. This is the maximum term according to the by-laws. In addition, she will no longer have a child in band as her daughter is graduating. Lisa Crosby had previously been nominated to serve as secretary and had agreed to accept the nomination and position. The floor was opened up for additional nominations of any one who would wish to serve as secretary. No other nominations were received. The floor was opened for voting to allow Lisa Crosby to be elected as secretary. The vote was received, seconded and carried with no opposing votes.
- **TREASURER:** Michele Bender has served the Band Boosters for two years as the secretary. This is the maximum term according to the by-laws. Kim Olson had previously been nominated to serve as treasurer and had agreed to accept the nomination and position. The floor was opened up for additional nominations of any one who would wish to serve as treasurer. No other nominations were received. The floor was opened for voting to allow Kim Olson to be elected as treasurer. The vote was received, seconded and carried with no opposing votes.

With the officer elections complete, Beth stated that we would still be needing committee chairpersons and volunteers would be asked to fill those positions. The parents were reminded to check the website ([www.prbandpirates.org](http://www.prbandpirates.org)) often for updates and information about band camp and the 2009/2010 school year schedule.

With no further business the meeting was enjoyed so that parents could enjoy the concert.
